Histories are time-consuming and difficult to write, but creating an entertaining visual history with Biography Films is easy. The person being interviewed simply gathers photos, sits back in a favorite chair, and talks.

The broadcast-quality biography is filmed on location with a digital cinema camera and professional lighting that make everyone look their best. The interviews are natural and unscripted, allowing those on camera to display their unique personality and humor. In fact, people often forget the camera is even there.

The interview footage is then brought to the studio to be edited with photographs, archival period films, and selected music. Many hours are spent in the editing room creating a narrative, adding motion photo effects, and fine-tuning the soundtrack. Finally, an animated title sequence is added before the completed biography is delivered as an emotionally engaging DVD.
